

Amazingly Diverse Group/Classroom Activity

Day 1- Introduction and Coloring Day – Card 1 and Card 2	Day 2- Coloring Day – Card 3 and Card 4	Day 3- Coloring Day- Card 5 and Card 6	Day 4- Coloring Day Card # 7 and Matching Card Game Day
<p>Introduction: <i>“We are going to do an art activity today that celebrates AMAZINGLY DIVERSE children. People come in all different colors, shapes and sizes. We believe in different things but are still the same human family. We are AMAZINGLY DIVERSE! You will hear different stories about AMAZINGLY DIVERSE children loving and caring for each other. Make sure you listen to the stories carefully! If you answer the questions correctly, you will win a prize! After, you will color the blank cards as close as you can to the colored cards.”</i></p> <p>Give each child Cards #1 and Cards #2 (one BW and one Colored of each). Before instructing them to color, read the story in the guide associated with each card and ask the reading comprehension questions. Ask children to raise their hands if they know the answer and call on them individually to answer. Reward children with small prizes (i.e. stickers) for correct answers. For additional questions that ensure everyone gets a prize, ask each child to name one of their AMAZINGLY DIVERSE friends or ways they can be kind to their friends.</p> <p>Note to parent/teacher: If you notice children do not have Amazingly Diverse friends, reward them for stating ways to be kind. Consider introducing our other activities, books and videos with positive diverse characters (contact bgibson@thebiasadjuster.com for activities). Replay Amazingly Diverse after introducing positive Black characters activities.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Estimated Time- 45 mins to an hour</p>	<p>Give each child Cards #3 and Cards #4 (one BW and one Colored of each). Before instructing them to color, read the story in the guide associated with each card and ask the reading comprehension questions. Ask children to raise their hands if they know the answer and call on them individually to answer. Reward children with small prizes (i.e. stickers) for correct answers. For additional questions that ensure everyone gets a prize, ask each child to name one of their different AMAZINGLY DIVERSE friends or ways they can be kind to their friends.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Estimated Time: 30-45 mins</p>	<p>Give each child Cards #5 and Cards #6 (one BW and one Colored of each). Before instructing them to color, read the story in the guide associated with each card and ask the reading comprehension questions. Ask children to raise their hands if they know the answer and call on them individually to answer. Reward children with small prizes (i.e. stickers) for correct answers. For additional questions that ensure everyone gets a prize, ask each child to name one of their different AMAZINGLY DIVERSE friends or ways they can be kind to their friends.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Estimated Time: 30-45 mins</p>	<p>Give each child Cards #7 (one BW and one Colored). Before instructing them to color, read the story in the guide associated with each card and ask the reading comprehension questions. Ask children to raise their hands if they know the answer and call on them individually to answer. Reward children with small prizes (i.e. stickers) for correct answers. For additional questions that ensure everyone gets a prize, ask each child to name one of their different AMAZINGLY DIVERSE friends or ways they can be kind to their friends.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Matching Card Game Day</p> <p>Allow each child to sit down with their cards and match them. This can be a timed event or children can race to find the matches. Winners can receive a small prize. This can be played multiple times to allow for multiple winners.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Estimated Time: 45 mins</p>
